

BY-LAWS OF THE FAIRFIELD COUNTY WOMEN'S PLATFORM TENNIS LEAGUE

The name of this organization is the Fairfield County Women's Platform Tennis League

Board of Directors – Roles and Responsibilities

The duties of the Board of Directors shall be to govern, interpret and arbitrate the activities of the Fairfield County Women's Platform Tennis League (FCWPTL) in accordance with the By-Laws and the rules (attached). They are also responsible for maintaining the "Spirit of the League".

The officers of the organization shall consist of the Chairman and/or Co-Chairman, secretary, treasurer, rules and by-laws chair, club/pro liaison, social chairman and website administrator. Positions may be added or removed as the Board grows or to better serve the league.

Each member of the Board shall serve for a maximum three year term in the same office. Board members may continue for additional terms but are encouraged to assume different positions.

The Board will meet on a regular basis as deemed necessary by the Board to discuss rules, regulations and/or any issues regarding the league.

The Treasurer must always keep an accurate account balance of the FCWTPL funds. At least twice-per-year the Treasurer must produce a complete financial report to the Board.

The voting members of the Board of Directors shall consist of the members as described above. There will be one vote per member. A simple majority of votes will pass any issue brought forward for approval.

A Board vote is required for any issue that will result in the change to the By-Laws or any rules of the FCWPTL.

Confidentiality: It is the responsibility of each Board member to maintain confidentiality and professionalism with regards to any and all information discussed in Board meetings regarding the league.

Indemnification: The Board of Directors of the FCWPTL is a volunteer board and is bound by the By-Laws and the Rules as set forth each year. Each volunteer member individually and collectively is covered by The Volunteer Protection Act, 42 USC 14501 ET. SEQ. (The "Act").
